

## Type 1 (3<sup>rd</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Mixed Conditionals) Exercise

Make third / second mixed conditionals where the condition is in the past and the result is in the present. Use short forms where possible.

**‘If + past perfect (past condition), would + verb (present result)’.**

5. I **wouldn't be** anxious if **you'd remembered** to call me this morning.
6. **They'd be** ready now if **they'd arrived** earlier.
7. I **wouldn't have** so much work now if **I'd organised** my time better yesterday.
8. They **wouldn't be** tired now if **they'd rested** in the afternoon.
9. If **they'd offered** me that new job last month, **I'd be** at the office now.
10. If **they'd invited** us last Friday, **we'd be** there now.
11. If she **hadn't spent** so much money over summer, **she'd travel** more now.
12. If **we'd completed** the project last week, **we'd be** free now.
13. If **we'd left** earlier, we **wouldn't be** stuck in traffic at this moment.
14. If **I'd seen** the notice yesterday, **I'd be** prepared now!
15. **We'd understand** these instructions if my little brother **hadn't written** all over them.
16. He **wouldn't feel** guilty now if **he'd kept** his promise.
17. If I **hadn't stayed** up so late, I **wouldn't be** exhausted today.
18. If **they'd listened** carefully, **they'd understand** today's instructions.
